Solar Cooker Workshop in Eldoret

In September of 2022, a workshop was conducted in Eldoret, Kenya, which included seven days of training with materials provided by Haines Solar Cookers. The training gave each of the twenty participants a training manual and workbook filled with illustrations and an explanation of the science behind solar cooking. Participants spent each day using groceries purchased at the local market each morning. Participants cooked various types of food such as cake, bread, beans, meats, and various traditional dishes. \$40 = Training of a solar cooking trainer/distributor (ambassador) in a rural village, and the means to effect change within their community.


\$75 = Three solar cooker kits for three families, and a smoke-free environment.

different aspect of learning about solar cooking. A WhatsApp group was also created at the end for the participants to share their solar cooking photos, answer questions, and offer encouragement. At the end of the cooking workshop, the participants thought the cooking that had been cooked using solar tasted better than food cooked using fire. This showed that the Haines Solar Cookers can be made by the participants with the materials that were provided, and that solar energy can be used to cook a variety of food such as cakes and bread.
